2:100 Board Member Conflict of Interest

No Board member shall: (1) have a beneficial interest directly or indirectly in any contract, work, or business of KASEC unless permitted by State or federal law; or (2) solicit or accept gratuities, favors, or anything of monetary value from contractors, potential contractors, or parties to agreements or contracts with KASEC.

Situations in which the interest is not substantial or the gift is an unsolicited item of nominal value must comply with State law and Board policy2:105, Ethics and Gift Ban.

Board members must annually file a Statement of Economic Interests as required by the Illinois Governmental Ethics Act. Each member is responsible for filing the statement with the county clerk of the county in which the Cooperative's/Joint Agreement's main office is located by May 1.
