7:250 Student Support Services

The following student support services may be provided by KASEC:

- 1. A liaison to facilitate the enrollment and transfer of records of students in the legal custody of the Illinois Department of Children and Family Services when enrolling in or changing schools.
- Services of a social worker.

The Director or designee shall develop protocols for responding to students with social, emotional, or mental health needs that impact learning ability. KASEC, however, assumes no liability for preventing, identifying, or treating such needs.

This policy shall be implemented in a manner consistent with State and federal laws, including the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, 42 U.S.C. §12101 <u>et seq</u>.
