8:80 Gifts to KASEC

KASEC appreciates gifts from any education foundation, other entities, or individuals. All gifts must adhere to each of the following:

- 1. Be accepted by the Executive Board or, if less than \$500.00 in value, the Director or designee. Individuals should obtain a pre-acceptance commitment before identifying KASEC or any KASEC program activity as a beneficiary in any fundraising attempt, including without limitation, any Internet fundraising attempt.
- 2. Be given without a stated purpose or with a purpose deemed by the party with authority to accept the gift to be compatible with the Board's educational objectives and policies.
- 3. Be consistent with KASEC's mandate to provide equal educational and extracurricular opportunities to all students in KASEC as provided in Board policy 7:10, *Equal Educational Opportunities*. State and federal laws require KASEC to provide equal treatment for members of both sexes to educational programing, extracurricular activities, and athletics. This includes the distribution of athletic benefits and opportunities.
- 4. Permit KASEC to maintain resource equity among its learning centers.
- 5. Be viewpoint neutral. The Director or designee shall manage a process for the review and approval of donations involving the incorporation of messages into or placing messages upon school property.
- Comply with all laws applicable to KASEC including, without limitation, the Americans with Disabilities Act, the Prevailing Wage Act, the Health/Life Safety Code for Public Schools, and all applicable procurement and bidding requirements.

KASEC will provide equal treatment to all individuals and entities seeking to donate money or a gift. Upon acceptance, all gifts become KASEC's property. The acceptance of a gift is not an endorsement by the Board, KASEC, or school of any product, service, activity, or program. The method of recognition is determined by the party accepting the gift.
